



## Prescription and Over-the-Counter Medication Consent & Instruction Record

- Physician's written instructions are required for the administration of all medication (prescription and over-the-counter) to the child.
- Parent/guardian acknowledges and agrees that parent/guardian is free to make arrangements to come to Stratford School in order to administer the medication to his/her child. As a convenience only, Stratford school agrees to administer necessary oral or topical medications (prescription and over-the-counter) provided parent(s)/guardian(s) are not available to do so and agree to all the terms in this Consent & Instruction Record. Parent's/guardian's signature must be obtained for the administration of the medication to the child. By this signature, parent/guardian authorizes Stratford School to administer the medications listed below. In addition, by signing below, parent/guardian releases Stratford School, its teachers and other staff from any and all responsibility in relation to the maintenance and/or administration of the medication indicated below.
- Prescription oral and topical medication will be administered in accordance with the physician's written instructions. If the physician's instructions conflict with the prescription label, Stratford School will not administer the medication unless and until written clarification and resolution of the conflict is provided by the physician. Parent/Guardian of the child is responsible for obtaining the written clarification and resolution.
- Medication must be in its original container with an unaltered label.
- Instruction from the physician supersedes instruction from the student's parent/guardian. Accordingly, if a parent's/guardian's instruction conflicts with the physician's written instructions, the physician's written instructions will be followed. For this reason, any parent/guardian who believes that the physician's written instructions should not be followed must present a new written instruction from the physician changing the original instructions.
- Stratford School will not under any circumstances administer medication other than that taken orally or administered topically except as otherwise mandated by applicable law. If Stratford is compelled by applicable law to administer any non-oral or non-topical necessary medication, by signing below, parent/guardian agrees that all the provisions of this Consent & Instruction Record also apply to administration of such non-oral or non-topical necessary medication.
