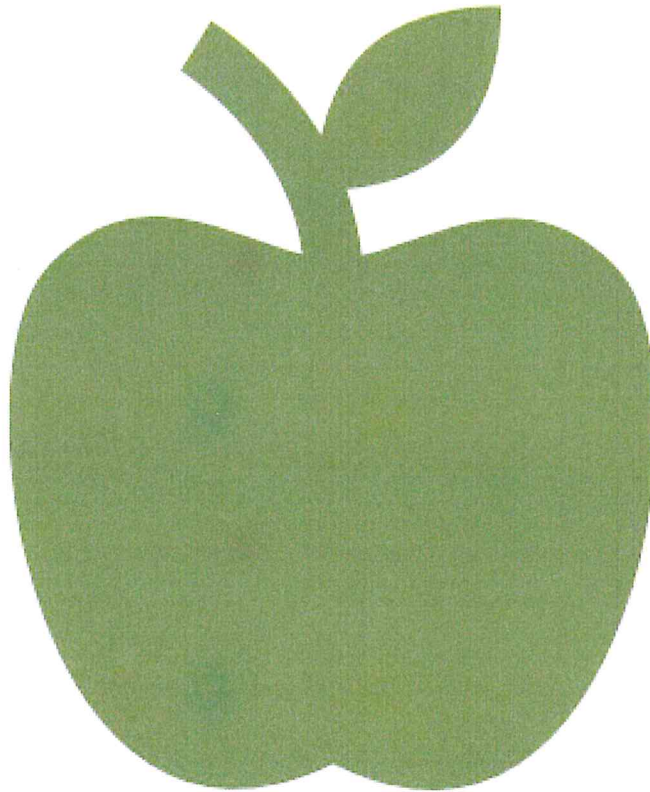

Visitor Information

(POST ON WEBSITE AND AT ALL SCHOOL ENTRANCES)

VISITORS/VOLUNTEERS

The school allows only necessary visitors and volunteers on the campus and will limit the number of students and staff who come into contact with them.

FACE COVERINGS - We will support students and staff wearing masks by:

Providing reminders of proper use, providing extra masks when soiled or forgotten, keeping stakeholders informed of what types of masks work best.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING - We will support physical distancing by:

keeping desks 6 feet apart, encouraging distant play, markers in the hallway, barriers between sinks in restrooms, having zones on the playground to prevent mixing of cohorts.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

We will support cleaning and maintenance of our campus by:

Sanitizing high touch areas, hiring a reputable janitorial service that cleans and sanitizes nightly, posting signage to remind staff and students to clean items after use, providing individual supplies

HYGIENE - We will support routine and frequent handwashing by:

Providing extra time during the day for washing hands before and after recess as well as before and after meals. Students are allowed and encouraged to wash their hands as often as needed. Access to hand sanitizer in every room.

ROUTINE TESTING - We will encourage and support staff testing by:

We encourage half of the staff to get tested every month. Provide information on where to get testing.

- **Families are required to report known cases of COVID-19 in their household to the school immediately. The school will report all known COVID-19 cases to Santa Clara Public Health.**
