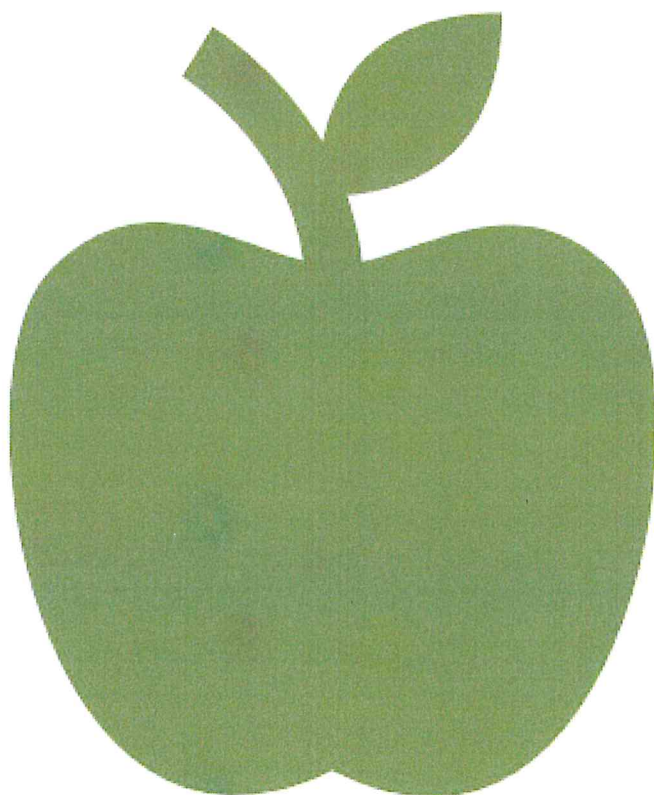

Visitor Information

(POST ON WEBSITE AND AT ALL SCHOOL ENTRANCES)

VISITORS/VOLUNTEERS

The school allows only necessary visitors and volunteers on the campus and will limit the number of students and staff who come into contact with them.

FACE COVERINGS - We will support students and staff wearing masks by:

Requiring all Staff and Students to wear masks at school. We have signs posted throughout the campus and on the front gates reminding all to wear their masks.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING - We will support physical distancing by:

We have arrows on the ground to ensure that students physically distance in the halls. Each class has markings for students that are 6 feet apart outside. The desks in each classroom are marked as 6ft. apart. Classes have specific places to hang out and eat outside and each of these have 6ft. markings.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

We will support cleaning and maintenance of our campus by:

Students will clean their desks with disinfectant every time they re-enter the classroom. Staff will clean the front of the classroom and anything they touched before leaving the classroom. Staff will clean high touch areas at least twice a day. Every evening, the campus is thoroughly cleaned by the janitorial crew.

HYGIENE - We will support routine and frequent handwashing by:

Students are required to wash their hands as they enter the classroom and any additional time they leave or re-enter the classroom. Staff is supposed to wash their hands as they enter and leave a classroom and the break room.

ROUTINE TESTING - We will encourage and support staff testing by:

Stratford is actively negotiating a contract with the external on-site testing service provider, KYLA (www.kyla.com). At Stratford Schools in Santa Clara County, as testing capacity permits and as practicable, we will offer options for testing to 50% of our school staff every month on a rotating basis. The employees who have health care coverage through the company have access to free COVID testing through UnitedHealth, Kaiser, and all have access through local community testing sites. In the event that employees choose not to use our onsite testing, Stratford asks that the employees get tested periodically by their health care provider or community testing sites.

- Families are required to report known cases of COVID-19 in their household to the school immediately. The school will report all known COVID-19 cases to Santa Clara Public Health.
