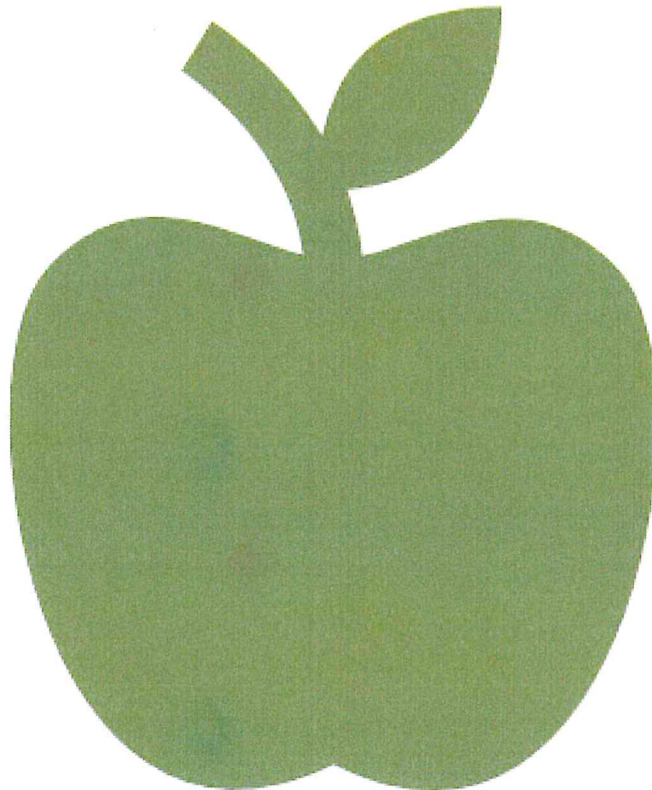

# School Preparedness Plan to Meet County Guidance for COVID-19

## Visitor Information

(POST ON WEBSITE AND AT ALL SCHOOL ENTRANCES)

### VISITORS/VOLUNTEERS

**The school allows only necessary visitors and volunteers on the campus and will limit the number of students and staff who come into contact with them.**

### FACE COVERINGS - We will support students and staff wearing masks by:

Teachers: Modeling wearing a mask at all times. Practicing good hygiene while wearing a mask-not touching and removing mask. Getting a fresh mask when necessary.

Students: wear a mask unless eating or drinking. Students may remove their mask at recess as long as they maintain six feet of social distancing. Receiving a fresh mask as necessary.

### PHYSICAL DISTANCING - We will support physical distancing by:

Marking desks 6 feet apart and maintaining the distance between desks. We have marked both inside and outside the classrooms so that students know where to stand. We model social distancing as teachers for our students. We have specific bathrooms and specific urinals/ toilets/ sinks marked for specific grade levels (with signage). The students are separated with specific cohorts at all times during their school day.

### CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

#### We will support cleaning and maintenance of our campus by:

Disinfecting the playground after every use. Our nightly cleaning crew thoroughly cleans every night. We disinfect both classrooms and bathrooms twice a day. We also disinfect all high touch surface areas after each (i.e copier, laminator, etc). We keep disinfecting supplies accessible for teachers in bathrooms and classrooms. We also have touchless soap and paper towel dispensers.

### HYGIENE - We will support routine and frequent handwashing by:

Modeling good handwashing habits for our students. We have signage posted to remind both staff and students the effectiveness and importance of it. The teachers have intentionally planned for handwashing as a part of their schedules to ensure students was before and after meals and recesses.

### ROUTINE TESTING - We will encourage and support staff testing by:

We remind staff to get tested at least every other month. We provide testing information to them.

- Families are required to report known cases of COVID-19 in their household to the school immediately. The school will report all known COVID-19 cases to Santa Clara Public Health.
