### **Academic and Enrichment Fees**

#### **Academic Fees**

**Books:** \$420 average annually (range \$250-\$800)

**AP Test Fee:** \$95 per test

#### Co-Curricular Program Fees

Participation in certain groups, activities, and competitions may require students to pay for specialized technology and equipment, team uniforms or performance wardrobe, competition fees, travel, and other expenses.

The estimated cost of participation and the schedule of events will be made available in advance and students and parents must agree to the program fee before the student is allowed to join.

We expect clubs and activities attending local events and competitions (e.g. Model United Nations, community-based clubs) to have less of a participation fee than clubs and activities attending state or national events and competitions (e.g. Robotics, Speech and Debate).

## **Athletics Participation Fees**

# Interscholastic Athletics Participation Fees

An athletic participation fee is required for each interscholastic sport. This fee offsets the costs of school trainers, coaches, transportation to and from athletic competitions, repair and reconditioning of safety equipment, required uniforms, and referee costs.

Athletes who try out and become official team members will be required to pay the participation fee prior to the first official competition in order to be eligible to compete. The athletics participation fee is non-refundable. The participation fee will not be refunded if the student voluntarily leaves, is injured, or is dismissed from the athletic team.

There is no relationship between athletic fees and a guarantee of playing time. Playing time for athletes is at the sole discretion of the head coach and their staff.

# Intramural Athletics Participation Fees

An athletic participation fee is required for each season of intramural sports. Intramural athletics will be majority student-run, and this fee offsets the costs of school trainers, coaches, and repair and reconditioning of safety equipment.

The participation fee is non-refundable. The participation fee will not be refunded if the student voluntarily leaves, is injured, or is dismissed from the intramural team.

### **Transportation**

In our effort to provide access to the High School program from neighboring Stratford Middle Schools and contribute to a more sustainable environmental future, Stratford Preparatory High School will offer bus transportation.

**OPTION 1:** Round Trip (both morning and afternoon routes; students must ride the same routes daily)

Early Registration: **\$3,200** Regular Registration: **\$3,900** 

**OPTION 2**: One Way (either morning or afternoon route; students must ride the same route daily)

Early Registration: **\$2,200** Regular Registration: **\$2,700** 

**OPTION 3:** Round Trip "Bus Hopper" (when there are both 3:45 pm and 5:30 pm options, students may ride either route any day)

Early Registration: \$3,400 Regular Registration: \$4,200

Transportation registration is available to students attending Stratford Preparatory, Grades 6-12. The Transportation registration is non-refundable and non-transferable.
