Our program is organized into five subject areas that are designed to provide your child with opportunities to learn valuable life skills and to reinforce the skills they're learning during the school day.



Students explore the exciting world of science, technology, engineering, art and math (STEAM) through building projects, experiments, and design challenges. Sharing ideas, asking questions, and making predictions are encouraged!



Robust outdoor free play and structured games help students learn sportsmanship and develop their physical strength and endurance. Students learn critical thinking and problem solving by participating in board games and team challenges with their peers.



Students express themselves by participating in hands-on visual arts, including photography, videography, drawing, and painting. Students develop planning skills by working on long-term projects with their peers and can participate in group performances or discussions.



Social and emotional growth is nurtured through student and teacher led activities that promote a feeling of community and belonging. Students learn through open-ended activities that give them a chance to apply problem-solving skills and collaborate with friends.

Tech & Engineering: Robotics Explorers: Fundamentals of AI and Robotics

This program introduces kids to the fundamentals of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and robotics through interactive, hands-on learning. The curriculum builds progressively from basic robotics to AI-enhanced robots, focusing on creativity, problem-solving, and teamwork. Students will understand how AI enhances robot capabilities, gain beginner coding and machine learning experience, and build robots that interact intelligently with their environment. In our classes we will use Lego Mindstorms robotics kits, Microbit and other tools.

We will use different robotics kits to explore and learn the main concepts of robotics and programming, including design and building, algorithms, testing, and troubleshooting. We will also talk about and explore the nature of sound, electricity, magnetism, basic math and geometry concepts, and many more. We will work with Coding Mouse, Botley Robot, Dash and Dot Robots and building blocks. All lessons are project-based, hands-on, using age-appropriate materials. We will explore algorithms with the Coding Mouse robot, resolve challenges and obstacles with the Botley robot, play bowling, play xylophone, and much more with the Dash and Dot robots.

Students explore rhythm and melody by playing with music from around the world with a focus on the Orff-Schulwerk methodology. Orff-trained teachers lead dynamic classroom activities designed especially for children ages 3-5. As they drum, sing, move to different rhythms, and play music-centered games, children naturally build musicality that helps them prepare for formal music lessons. The focus of our classes is on keeping an accurate beat, singing in key, and managing social situations (taking turns, listening to others). Opportunities to solo, work in ensembles, and improvise support social and listening skills, self-expression, and self-confidence. Besides our emphasis on fun, our program is an excellent preparation for ANY other instrument lessons!
